

Dear Parents and Carers,

Below are the 2017 end of year targets for a Year 2 student to achieve a satisfactory grade (C Grade) for Mathematics and English.

Mathematics

Number & Algebra

- Counts to and from 1000.
- Performs simple addition and subtraction calculations using a range of strategies.
- Represents multiplication and division by grouping into equal sized groups or sets.
- Divides collections and shapes into halves, guarters and eighths.
- Connects collections of Australian coins according to their value.
- Recognises increasing and decreasing number sequences involving twos, threes and fives.
- Identifies the missing element in a number sequence.

Measurement & Geometry

- Orders shapes and objects by length, area, volume and capacity using uniform, informal
 units.
- Tells the time to the quarter hour.
- Uses a calendar to identify the date and the months included in seasons.
- Draws two-dimensional shapes and recognises the features of three-dimensional objects.
- Interprets simple maps of familiar locations.
- Explains the effects of one-step transformations of shapes using the language of flip, slide and turn.

Statistics & Probability

- Describes the outcomes for everyday events using the language of chance.
- Makes sense of collected data and organises and represents data appropriately.
- Makes simple inferences from collected data.

English

Writing & Creating

- Writes simple and compound sentences.
- Uses topic-specific vocabulary, adjectives and/or adverbs to enhance a noun group/phrase.
- Spells familiar words and attempts to spell less familiar words.
- Correctly uses punctuation, such as capital letters at the beginning of sentences and for proper nouns, full stops and commas.

Reading & Viewing

- Identifies some characteristics of imaginative, persuasive and informative texts to suit purpose.
- Identifies the purpose and intended audience of some different texts.
- States own response to characters, events and settings in texts, using an example from the text
- Identifies key similarities and differences between different texts on the same topic

Speaking & Listening

- Speaks clearly and audibly to familiar audiences
- Plans, rehearses and delivers short presentations on familiar or learned topics
