

Green Team Representatives

The SDPS Green Team is looking for applicants for the 2017 school year. The team will start in Week 8. The Green Team at Sutherland Dianella Primary School will be made up of two representatives from each year level; from Year 1 to 6.

Tasks will include:

- Tending the vegetable gardens – Watering, weeding, harvesting produce, sowing seeds, fertilizing, bug spotting and selling produce.
- Looking after the worm farm – feeding the worms organic waste, collecting worm juice, checking temperature and moisture content of worm farm.
- Maintaining a recycling system for organic waste, paper and cardboard waste, aluminium waste, battery, printer cartridge and cell phone collection.
- Planning and participating in tree planting projects around the school grounds.

Your commitment

One day a week - duties include:

- (8:30 – 8:40) Setting up recycling bins in lunch areas around school
- (12:30 – 12:55) Collect organic waste from lunch areas for the worm farm; and to compost. Rinsing organic waste bins. Collecting paper, cardboard and aluminium can bins for recycling. Watering vegetable garden and checking for bugs.

Once a week tasks - duties include:

- Harvesting, planting, weeding in vegetable gardens.
- Collecting worm juice

If you have other commitments on your assigned day you need to let Mr Goulter know so we can organise other helpers, or change your rostered day.

Rewards

- At the end of semester there will be a reward activity planned.
- You will be provided with a badge to show you are a Green Team Member, which is worn on your collar.
- Values tokens are awarded to those who perform over and above expectations.
