

Dear Parents and Carers

The majority of BYOD notes have been returned from A3 and A4 and there is sufficient interest in the BYOD pre-cursor opportunity, to go ahead.

If you have not yet returned the iPromise for your child, please do so by the end of the term.

Students cannot access their iPads in Term 3 without a completed, signed and submitted iPromise.

At the start of Term 3, Tuesday 18 July, all iPads are to be dropped into the office with your child's name on it and the access code to open the iPad. Mr Ingersole will join all iPads to the network and then give them back to the students in their classes. We anticipate we would be able to get all iPads onto the network in a day.

All students will be accessing Department of Education email via their portal in the first week of Term 3.

At any point where teachers wish to request apps to be loaded for educational purposes, they will send home a note to parents. There will NOT be any requests for paid apps in 2017.

We ask that parents support the school's approach to iPads, in that they are a 'tool' not a 'toy', while they are at school. Parents are reminded to ensure they are cyber aware with devices in the home and should follow guidelines as outline in the website below.
