On **Thursday 4 May** the Year Two students will be attending an excursion to Tranby House in Maylands.

The program allows students to explore family life in the past and compare it to the present day. The activities include:

- The Tranby story – history of a significant historical site
- Tour of Tranby – compare daily life and technology past and present
- ‘Time to Play’ – play old fashioned games and compare technology to present day toys and games
- Artefacts – compare objects from the past and present and discuss the impact of changing technology on people’s lives
- Windmill craft – investigate the process of growing wheat in the ‘olden days’ and make a wind powered mill

Students will travel by bus leaving school at 8.45am and returning at approximately 2.00pm.
